



Zoo Edventure Camp Safety Expectations **Effective April 21, 2021**

In keeping with the Lee Richardson Zoo's (Zoo) educational mission to inspire appreciation and stewardship of the natural world, the Zoo will provide onsite Zoo Edventure Camp only under the following conditions to help us best achieve our mission.

For the safety of the Zoo's staff, volunteers, animals, and camp attendees, the following expectations have been put in place for the foreseeable future, due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

1. To ensure there is adequate space to maintain at least 3 feet of distance between individuals, Zoo Edventure programs will be limited to 16 individuals each week.
 - a. Games and activities will be modified to allow for safe distancing and limited sharing of tools and resources throughout the week.
2. Opportunities to see the animals or biofacts up-close will be offered when possible. The touching of any animals and/or biofacts by the attendees will not be part of the program.
3. Since the animals and zoo staff are not with you every day, we encourage masks be worn by all attendees (except the animals) when indoors and when social distancing is not possible by the group.

If more restrictive guidelines are put in place during the camp (i.e. a mask mandate, group size, etc..), those guidelines are expected to be followed as well.

Please send one signed copy of the contract and your payment to the Zoo and keep one copy for yourself.

I agree to meet all the conditions outlined in the above contract, or to notify the zoo in advance your scheduled Zoo Edventure Camp if said conditions cannot be met.
